If person to be appointed as a Chairman of the Commission holds any office under the State Government or in any public sector corporation or Government body he/she shall submit his/her resignation or take voluntary retirement from that service and shall not seek reappointment in the service of the State Government the Central Government, any public sector corporation or Government body at any time after he/she ceases to be Chairman of the Commission.
