- The Committee referred to the MoM dated 14.10.2014 wherein it was deliberated that the seniority lists of JE's & JE-I (Field Cadre) is required to be joined with seniority list of JE's & JE-I (Generation Cadre) for making compliance of the orders of Hon'ble High Court. It was also deliberated that during the year 1988 to 1998 the Cadre Controlling Authority of Field Cadre for the post of JEs and JE-I was CE/Operation, HSEB, Hisar now CE/HR & Admn., DHBVNL Hisar, as such, his office is custodian of record.
- 3 After deliberations, the Committee decided as under:-

- 2 The Committee noted the fact of not relieving of few members of the Sub-Committee as per MoM dated 18.09,2014 circulated vide Memo No Ch-41/HPG/GE-218-B/PH/Vol-II dated 30.09.2014 by Administrative Head of DHBVNL and absence of members of the sub-committee notified vide O/o No 133/GM/Admn dated 20.03.2014 during the Meeting on 20.10.2014 with grave concern. The CE/HR & Admn., DHBVNL, Hisar vide Memo No-Ch-43/HPG/GE-218-B/PH/Vol-II dated 09.10.2014 and as per directions at Sr No-3 (2) of MoM dated 14.10.2014 circulated vide Memo No Ch-52/HPG/GE-218-B/PH/Vol-II dated 14.10.2014 followed by E-Mail dated 14.10.2014 & SMS dated 16.10.2014 was requested to ensure supply of all relevant record relating to seniority lists of JEs & JE-I (Field Cadre) latest by 16.10.2014 through well conversant officers/officials.

Non-compliance of Orders is viewed seriously. As such, the CE/HR & Admn, DHBVNL to ensure initiation of disciplinary proceedings against delinquent officers/officials & compliance be placed on record in next meeting.

- 3 The Member Secretary may take up the matter telephonically with CE/HR & Admn., DHBVNL, Hisar for reliving of members of subcommittee of DHBVNL and their making available of all relevant record as sought by the joint sub-committee.
- The Committee appreciated the arduous job performed by the members of the Joint Sub-Committee for submission of spade work within specified time.
- The Committee decided that the next meeting of the Committee will be held on 27.10.2014 to analyse the progress made by the Joint Sub-Committee and to make a view on the Representations/Submissions given by the Petitioners/Respondents during the personal hearings as the personal hearing to the concerned has been concluded.

Barjesh Sub-Committee, HVPNL on Superintendent-cum-Chairman, dated 21.10.2014 made submission that the spade work regarding framing of common Seniority lists of Engineering Subordinates under 22.5% Diploma Holder Quota from amongst Generation Cadre & Field Cadre in compliance to Orders of the Hon'ble Court in CWP No. 10195 of 1993, 12395 of 1997, 11909 of 2006, 12099 of 2006, 17721 of 2006, 10168 of 2006 & 798 of 2007is yet to be started by the members enlisted from amongst sub-committees of utilities as per minutes of the meeting held on 18.09.2014. The perusal of MoM dated 04.04.2014 would reveal that all the Utilities had placed on record all the seniorities/regulations available in their records for the assistance of Main Committee which was attended by all members of the sub-committee of DHBVNL except Shri Arun Kumar, Sr AO. The Sub-Committee of DHBVNL had been participating in the proceedings of the meetings from time to time but none of the member has shown their responsibility for placing on record the seniorities relating with JEs of Field Cadre even when they knew that in the year 1988 to 1998, the Cadre Controlling Authority of Field Cadre for the post of JEs and JE-I was CE/Operation, HSEB, Hisar now CE/HR & Admn., DHBVNL Hisar. Despite best efforts and eloquence, the members of joint

It was also deliberated that during the year 1988 to 1998 the Cadre Controlling Authority of Field Cadre for the post of JEs and JE-I was CE/Operation, HSEB, Hisar now CE/HR & Admn., DHBVNL Hisar, as such, his office is custodian of record.

The following officials intimated that seniority lists of JE's (Field Cadre) appointed during the year 1989 is not forthcoming in their records and submitted that seniority list be re-derived from Merit List. (please refer to flag-58)

The Committee noted the fact of non-availability of seniority list of JEs (Diploma Holder) directly recruited in the year 1989 with grave concern.

e) An advice was requested to be imparted by the members of the Joint Sub-Committee as to whether the procedure for generating/ deriving the data is as per the requirement of the MoM dated 14.10.2014 meets with the directions of the main committee or otherwise. It was also requested to impart advice whether the Combined Seniority List of Junior Engineer/Junior Engineer-I (Diploma Holder) from amongst Field Cadre & Generation Cadre is required to be prepared w.e.f 19.02.1988 or from the date Junior Engineers who were appointed in the erstwhile HSEB as Direct Recruits in the year 1989.

The Committee deliberated on the following Civil Writ Petitions relating to Diploma Holder under 22.5% Quota:-(please refer to flag-58)

The committee deliberated that the dispute is amongst Junior Engineers who were appointed in the erstwhile HSEB as Direct Recruits in the year 1989.

f) The members of the Joint Sub-Committee placed on record letter from Secretary, HSEB, Panchkula wherein recommendations of Screening Committee has been forwarded to General Manager/PTPS, HSEB Panipat with copy to all Chief Engineers HSEB with the approval of Chairman, HSEB bearing Memo No.Ch-81/NGE/G-105 dated 29.04.1988, subject, "Creation of a distinct and separate Generation Cadre of JEs - Option therein-from". The recommendations are reproduced below:-

memo no. 36/NGE/O-105 dt. 11.11.1987 the options of these JEs working in Thermal/Hydel Projects on their receipt from respective CEs were entrusted to the screening Committee (s) for determining the suitability of such JEs being absorbed in the Generation cadre or otherwise. The report of the screening committee (s) was received with their due recommendations. These recommendations were considered carefully and it has been decided as under:-

(i) JEs/Thermal, as mentioned in the list marked as per Annexuer-'A' who have opted for the Generation Cadre and are also recommended by the Screening Committee for their absorption as such, may be allowed to be absorbed in the Generation Cadre.

(ii)Those JEs/field, as mentioned in the list marked as Annexuer-'B', presently working in Thermal Station or Hydel Station, Who have opted for the Generation Cadre and are recommended by the Screening Committee for absorption as such, may be allowed to be absorbed in the Generation Cadre subject to the terms of the letter calling options.

(iii) Those JEs/field, as per detail given in the list marked as Annexuer-'C', who have opted for field cadre but presently working in the Thermal/Hydel projects of HSEB may be allowed to be transferred

out of Generation organization.

(iv) Those JEs/field, as mentioned in the list attached and marked as Annexuer-'D', who have opted for the Generation Cadre but have not been recommended by the screening Committee for absorption as such are to be transferred out of Generation organization, but before making their transfer orders, such JEs are to be intimated about the recommendations of Screening Committee, such JEs can also prefer appeal to the Member Technical (O & P) in terms of clause(g) of the letter calling options and the result of the appeal no preferred by such JEs, may be awaited.

(v)The matter in respect of JEs/Thermal, as mentioned in the list attached and marked as Annexuer-'E', who have opted for Field organization is being looked into and decision regarding them shall be

communicated separately.

(vi) The decision in respect of those JEs/Thermal, as mentioned in the list attached and marked as Annexuer-'F', who have opted for Generation cadre but their names have not been recommended by Screening Committee for absorption is also being conveyed separately.

(vii) Those JEs/field, whose names are mentioned in the list attached and marked as Annexuer-'G', have given their conditional options contrary to the guidelines contained in letter calling options referred above may be allowed to continue in their original cadre.

It is again pointed out that the action on the point against (iv) above is to be taken in accordance with para-4(g) of the specimen option letter dated 11.11.87 issued by this office referred to above and determining of inter-se seniority of JEs/field as per point (ii) above is to be taken in accordance with para-4 (h) of the said
