specimen option letter.

3. You are, therefore, requested to take necessary action in the matter in the light of above under intimation to this office as well as to all concerned offices/officials concerned. The report /recommendations of the Screening Committee (s) shall be available with your office for authentication of Annexure-A to G which are enclosed herewith.

4. The above issues with the approval of the Chairman."

The Committee observed that in compliance of decision of Hon'ble High Court, Chandigarh in CWP No. 2953/87 titled as S.P. Kapoor, JE & others Vs HSEB, options were invited from amongst all JEs working in Thermal/Hydel Projects in HSEB vide memo no. 36/NGE/O-105 dt. 11.11.1987. After receipt of options, the suitability of such JEs being absorbed in Generation Cadre or otherwise was duly considered and the decision was circulated vide Memo No.Ch-81/NGE/G-105 dated 29.04.1988.

In view of above, it is clear that all the JEs were working in erstwhile HSEB, may it be Hydel/Thermal, their options were called and they were absorbed in Generation/Field Cadre as per their suitability based upon their options received. Their list was duly circulated, thus, this settles the claim of the JEs who were in service as on 11.11.1987. As such, no merger of cadre is required to be made.

Thereafter, recruitment in the cadre of JE was done in the year 1988 against advertisement No. CRA-95 wherein applications for 150 no. of posts of Trainee Junior Engineers (Field) was invited with a clear stipulation that on successful completion of the training they will be absorbed in regular service of HSEB as Junior Engineers (Field) and against CRA-95, a total of 55 No. were selected in January 1988. This settles the claim of the JEs who were selected in a specific cadre i.e. Field against CRA-95. As such, no merger of cadre is required to be made.

Thereafter, next recruitment in the cadre of JE was done in the year September-1989 against advertisement No. CRA-104 and 254 no. Trainee Junior Engineers were recruited and were posted in Generation Cadre & Field Cadre. As such, merger of seniority list of Junior Engineers (Diploma Holder) from amongst Generation & Field Cadre is required to be made.

- The committee deliberated the progress of work assigned as per MoM dated 04.04.2014 circulated vide Memo No Ch-25/HPG/GE-218/L dated 16.04.2014 &Sr. No. 03 of the MoM dated 10.09.2014 circulated vide Memo No. Ch-15/HPG/GE-218-B/PH/Vol-II dated 22.09.2014 and noted that the work is time consuming being voluminous which requires analytical legal perusal and is likely to be completed in next few days.

The members of the sub-committee of DHBVNL were requested to ratify the spade work submitted by the members of the joint committee.

In response, the members of the sub-committee of DHBVNL have confirmed the spade work on dated 21.10.2014 & 22.10.2014.

In supersession of this office order no. 33/Reg-18 dated 27.02.1989, the Haryana State Electricity Board is pleased to issue guidelines in order to implement the Recruitment & Promotion Policy in case of promotion to the post of Assistant Engineer from Engineering Subordinates possessing AMIE/BE qualifications in 12½% quota as contained in Regulation-9 (I) (b) (ii) and Regulation 9 (I) (c) (ii) of Punjab State Electricity Board Service of Engineers (Electrical) Recruitment Regulation, 1965 (as applicable to HSEB) and notified vide O/o No. 21/REG-18 dated: 19.02.1988, read with notification No. 167/REG-21/L-II dated: 12.10.1993 as under:-

(i) The determination of the eligibility for promotion will be the acquisition of qualification of AMIE/BE and completion of 5 years service in the cadre of Engineering Subordinates. The eligibility shall thus be determined on satisfying both the conditions i.e. passing of AMIE/BE examination and 5 years experience. The name(s) of the official will be entered in the ranking list from the date they complete both the conditions. If a candidate is recruited as Engineering subordinate having qualification of AMIE/BE, his eligibility for promotion will also be considered after he attained experience of 5 years on the post.

"The recruitment will be by promotion from Junior Engineer (Sub Station) on seniority-cum-merit basis provided he possess the minimum qualification as Matric with ITI trade course in Electrician/Electronics/Wireman Trade."

JE-I/Test

"The recruitment will be by promotion from Junior Engineer (Test) on seniority-cum-merit basis provided he possess the minimum qualification as Matric with ITI trade course in Electrician/Instrumentation/Electronics."

JE-I/Carrier

"The recruitment will be by promotion from Junior Engineer (Carrier) on seniority-cum-merit basis provided he possess the minimum qualification as Matric with ITI trade course in Electrician/Telecommunication/Electronics."
