Subject: Revised Tentative Ranking List of working Engineering Subordinates of HPGCL as on 25.08.2022.

In compliance to HPGCL Service of Engineers Electrical Regulation-2022, circulated vide letter Memo No. Ch-66/HPG/Genl-147/6538 dated 18.08.2022 and in suppression to this office Memo no. Ch-10/HPG/Genl-147/2022 dated 30.06.2022, the Revised Tentative Ranking List of working Engineering Subordinates of HPGCL as on 25.08.2022 has been prepared and attached as **Annexure-A** subject to the following conditions:-

1. The LR/HPUs in the matter of reorganization the degree of IME has advised that the matter may be taken up with AICTE/MHRD for the detail of diploma/degree courses conducted by different professional bodies which are valid for those candidates enrolled upto 31.05.2013. MHRD vide notification dated 24.11.2006, the student who were registered prior to 10.06.2002 for part I & II of Technician Engineers (Diploma Level) and Section A & B of Associate Membership course (Degree Level) will be allowed to complete the courses with pre-revised syllabus till the next scheduled examination, to be held in December 2006. Their Degree / Diploma will be recognized for employment in Central Government. Those who do not complete their courses by that time (December 2006) will have to follow the revised syllabus. Further, a vigilance enquiry and court case also pending on the above issue. **Accordingly, Degree issued by IME, Bombay prior to December, 2006 has been considered in the Revised Tentative Ranking List.**
2. The LR/HPUs has also advised vide letter dated 27.07.2022 (**Annexure-B**) that *judgment dated 22.12.2017 in CWP No. 16224/2016 titled as Salaudeen & Others V/s HVPNL & others has been stayed by Hon'ble Division Bench in LPA No. 26/2018 vide order dated 17.01.2018. Therefore, case of Ex-serviceman has been considered for inclusion in ranking list subject to final outcome of LPA 26/2018. Accordingly, equivalent Degree certificate awarded by Indian Navy/Armed forces/Air forces on 10 years service experience has been considered subject to final outcome of LPA 26/2018.*
3. The Ld. Advocate General (AG), Haryana for considering the certificates of passing AICTE – UGC special examination conduct by AICTE-UGC in 2018

has advised that *the degree of such employees/candidates who were not granted any benefit/advantage prior to the date of passing of the judgment i.e 03.11.2017 and who were also eligible for one time relaxation granted in the judgment, shall also stand validated on passing the examination conducted by AICTE- UGC in 1st or 2nd attempt. Such candidates shall be eligible for further consideration only from the date on which they passed the said examination i.e from the date when their degree stands validated (Annexure-C). Accordingly, degree issued by JRN Rajasthan Vidyapeeth University, Rajasthan and Institute of Advanced Studies in Education, Rajasthan has been considered.*

4. Degree issued by Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science & Technology, Murthal Distt. Sonapat has been considered in terms of State Govt., Haryana Notification No. 42/558/2021-5GS-I dated 29.12.2021 (Annexure-D).
5. The LR/HPUs in the matter regarding degree issued by IGNOU has also advised that degree certificate issued by IGNOU are valid only in respect of those student regarding considering the degree awarded by IGNOU that who were enrolled up to academic year 2011-12 in terms of Hon'ble Supreme Court decision dated 19.09.2020 passed in W.P no. (c) No. 1341 of 2019 titled as MD Naseem Baig & Ors V/s AICTE read with Circular No. AICTE/P&AP/IGNOU/Misc./2020 dated 25.11.2020.
6. The Engineering Subordinates promoted on premature basis have been considered into the Revised Tentative Ranking List on the basis of State Govt. Notification no. 2/84/2016-2GS-I dated 10.04.2017, i.e. only after completion of requisite experience on that post.


Further, the degree certificates submitted by Engineering Subordinate, mentioned in **Annexure-E**, are not included in the Revised Tentative Ranking List for want of requisite documents and as per above advices.

The aforementioned Revised Tentative Ranking List may be circulated to all Engineering Subordinates working under your control and get it noted from them. If any officer has any legitimate grievance/objection against the position to him/her therein and wishes to represent against it, he/she should do so within a period of 10 days from the date of issue of this letter.

The above said Revised Tentative Ranking List is subject to any Administrative orders/court orders/cases pending and would be further subject to outcome of such proceedings, if any.

With respect to issue relating to degree certificates awarded by Indian Navy/armed forces after completion of 10 years service is concerned, it is advised that judgement dated 22.12.2017 in CWP No. 16224/2016 titled as Salaudeen & Others Vs HVPNL & others has been stayed by Hon'ble Division Bench in LPA No. 26/2018 vide order dated 17.01.2018 which is now fixed for 07.11.2022. Therefore, case of Ex-servicemen may be considered for inclusion in ranking list. Subject to outcome of LPA 26/2018.

LEGAL OPINION

Sub: Request for consideration of name for promotion from JE-I (Degree Holder) to the post of AE under 121/2 % promotion quota.

I have perused the facts as narrated on CP 7-9 and the relevant Judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the AICTE circular dated 09.06.2020 (CP-10). The technical qualifications (B.Tech degree) obtained from the deemed to be Universities through distance education mode came up for consideration of the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Orissa State Lift Irrigation Corporation's case Vs. Rabi Sankar Patro & Ors., Civil Appeal No. 17869-17870 of 2017*. Vide Judgment dated 03.11.2017, the Hon'ble Court upheld the Judgment of the Division bench of Punjab & Haryana High Court in *Kartar Singh Vs. Union of India and others, 2013(1) RSJ 224* and directed that all the degrees in Engineering granted to students who were enrolled during the academic years 2001 to 2005 shall stand suspended till they pass such examination held under the joint supervision of AICTE-UGC. Further, every single advantage on the basis of that degree shall also stand suspended. It further directed that not more than two chances be given to the concerned students and if they do not pass the test/tests their degrees shall stand recalled and cancelled and any promotion or advancement in career on the basis of such degree shall also stand withdrawn, however any monetary benefits or advantages in that behalf shall not be recovered from them. The Hon'ble Court further declared that in respect of students admitted after the academic sessions of

2001-2005, the degrees in Engineering awarded by the concerned Deemed to be Universities through Distance Education Mode shall stand recalled and be treated as cancelled. Any benefit which a candidate has secured as a result of such degrees in Engineering in the nature of promotion or advancement in career shall also stand recalled. However, if any monetary benefit was derived by such candidates that monetary benefit or advantage will not be recovered by the concerned departments or employers. Para 46, 47 & 48 of the judgement are extracted herein below:

5. *Having found the entire exercise of grant of ex-post-facto approval to be incorrect and illegal, the logical course in normal circumstances would have been not only to set aside such ex-post-facto approvals but also to pass consequential directions to recall all the degrees granted in pursuance thereof in respect of Courses leading to award of degrees in Engineering. However, since 2004 UGC Guidelines themselves had given liberty to the concerned Deemed to be Universities to apply for ex-post-facto approval, the matter is required to be considered with some sympathy so that interest of those students who were enrolled during the academic sessions 2001- 2005 is protected.....We, therefore, direct that all the degrees in Engineering granted to students who were enrolled during the academic years 2001 to 2005 shall stand suspended till they pass such examination under the joint supervision of AICTE-UGC in the manner indicated hereinafter. Further, every single advantage on the basis of that degree shall also stand suspended.*

47. The AICTE is directed to devise within one month from the date of this judgment modalities to conduct appropriate test/tests both in written examination as well as in practicals for the concerned students admitted during the academic sessions 2001-2005 covering all the concerned subjects. It is entirely left to the discretion of AICTE to come out with such modalities as it may think appropriate and the tests in that behalf shall be conducted in the National Institutes of Technology in respective States wherever the students are located. The choice may be given to the students to appear at the examination which ideally should be conducted during May- June, 2018 or on such dates as AICTE may determine. Not more than two chances be given to the concerned students and if they do not pass the test/tests their degrees shall stand recalled and cancelled. If a particular student does not wish to appear in the test/tests, the entire money deposited by such student towards tuition and other charges shall be refunded to that student by the concerned Deemed to be University within a month of the exercise of such option. The students be given time till 15th of January, 2018 to exercise such option. The entire expenditure for conducting the test/tests in respect of students who wish to undergo test/tests shall be recovered from the concerned Deemed to be Universities by 31.03.2018. If they clear the test/tests within the stipulated time, all the advantages or benefits shall be restored to the concerned candidates. We make it clear at the cost of repetition that if the concerned candidates do not clear the test/tests within the time stipulated or choose not to appear at the test/tests, their degrees in Engineering through distance education shall stand recalled and cancelled. It goes without saying that any promotion or advancement in career on the basis of such degree shall also

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stand withdrawn, however any monetary benefits or advantages in that behalf shall not be recovered from them.

48. As regards the students who were admitted after the ex-post-facto approval granted in favour of such Deemed to be Universities, in our view, there was no sanction whatsoever for their admission. The Policy Statements as well as warnings issued from time to time were absolutely clear. The students were admitted on the strength either provisional recognition or on the strength of interim orders passed by the High Court. We therefore, declare that in respect of students admitted after the academic sessions of 2001-2005, the degrees in Engineering awarded by the concerned Deemed to be Universities through Distance Education Mode shall stand recalled and be treated as cancelled. Any benefit which a candidate has secured as a result of such degrees in Engineering in the nature of promotion or advancement in career shall also stand recalled. However, if any monetary benefit was derived by such candidates that monetary benefit or advantage will not be recovered by the concerned departments or employers...."

Further, vide Order dated 22.01.2018 passed in various Interim Applications filed subsequently in this case, the Hon'ble Court granted a one-time relaxation in favour of those candidates who were enrolled during the academic years 2001-2005 and who exercised option to appear in the test in terms of the judgment, to retain the degrees in question and all the advantages flowing therefrom (instead of suspension of their degrees and the benefits) till one month after the declaration of the result of such test or till 31.07.2018 whichever is

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earlier and that if the benefits are withdrawn from them after 31st of July or on failing to pass the examination in the first attempt then on passing the examination in the first or second chance, as the case may be, they would be protected by the direction given in para 53(VI) of the Judgment to the extent that their degrees will stand revived fully and all the advantages/benefits will be restored to them.

It will be pertinent to mention here that some of the employees of Public Health Engineering Department Haryana filed a Contempt Petition in Hon'ble Apex Court being, *CONMT. PET. (C) Nos 408-09/2019 in C.A. Nos. 17869-17870/2017 titled as Ashok Kumar & Ors. Vs. Depinder Singh, Dhesi & Ors.*, alleging violation of the judgement dated 030 11.2017 passed by the court in *Orissa Lift Irrigation Corporation case (supra)* and other connected matters. The Petitioners therein had pleaded in the Contempt Petition that "*However, after the Petitioners have cleared the June 2018 AICTE exam their degrees have become valid and hence they are to be treated at par with those Junior Engineers who have obtained their Degrees through the Regular Mode. The fact that the Petitioners have been ignored and the ACRs of the Junior Candidates have been called for shows that the Contemnors / Respondents have deliberately and wilfully violated the directions of this Hon'ble Court passed in Judgment dated 03.11.2017 and 22.01.2018.*"

After considering para 46, 47 & 48 of the Judgment dated 03.11.2017 and the Order dated 22.01.2018, the Hon'ble Court held as follows:

"9. Some candidates approached this Court submitting that if in terms of the Judgment the benefits or advantages were to be withdrawn and could be regranted or restored only after the candidates had cleared the examination, it may entail some prejudice to the candidates. Some of the candidates who had obtained Post-Graduate Degrees and were employed on the strength of such Degrees would be required to surrender such benefits; and even if they were to pass the examination in the first attempt, it may still require restoration of the benefits leading to situations of inconvenience and prejudice. The directions in the Judgment were therefore modified to a certain extent in the Order. It was, therefore, laid down by way of further concession in the Order that all the candidates who desired to appear in the upcoming examination could retain all the advantages and benefits till one month after declaration of the result of test or till 31.07.2018 whichever was later. The benefit of retaining the advantages was thus extended only till the first attempt. Those who could not clear the examination in first attempt or chose not to appear in the examination conducted in May/June, 2018 were not entitled to the concessions extended by the Order.

"10. It was, therefore, clear that the candidates who, on the strength of such Degrees awarded through Distance Education Mode, had attained a particular level in their career or were enjoying certain benefits as on the date of the Judgment and if they pass the examination, those benefits would stand restored. If the candidates could clear the examination in the first attempt itself, there would not even be any break in continuous enjoyment of those benefits or facilities. The idea was, candidates should

not stand deprived of the status that they were enjoying as on the day of the Judgment provided the candidates could prove their worth and ability.

But if, the concerned candidates had not attained any particular status, as on the date when the Judgment was passed, the width of the directions was not to confer any additional advantage which was not even enjoyed as on the date. It was not the idea to hold the candidates to be entitled to certain additional benefits which the candidates were, as a matter of fact, not even enjoying on the date of the judgment. If the degrees stood restored in terms of the directions in the Judgment and the Order, the candidates would certainly be eligible to such entitlements as are available in accordance with law, but "restoration" would only be of those benefits, which they were enjoying as on the date of the Judgment. In short, the intent was to restore status quo ante and not to confer any additional advantage by the Judgment and the Order.

The Hon'ble Court has therefore clarified the two aspects of the concession extended in Judgment dated 03.11.2017, one is restoration of degree in terms of the directions in the Judgment, as a consequence of which, the candidates would be eligible to the entitlements in accordance with law and the second one is 'restoration' which would be only of the benefits which the candidates were enjoying on the date of the Judgment. Therefore, the employees, who were not granted/enjoying any benefits on the date of passing of the Judgment but whose degrees now stand restored as per the directions given in paras 46 & 47 of the Judgment would certainly be eligible for

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consideration for the entitlements from the date of validation of their degrees i.e. from the date of passing the examination.

In a recent Judgment passed in *Writ Petition (Civil) No. 1510 of 2018 titled as Vinit Garg and Others Vs. University Grants Commission & Ors., decided on 29.08.2019*, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has again clarified that that no relief can be granted to the candidates who had taken admission in 2005 or thereafter. Relief in the form of one time relaxation vide examination to be conducted by the AICTE was granted to those candidates/students who had taken admission in academic years beginning from 2001 and till 2004-2005.

The various directions given in the afore-stated Judgments can be summarized as follows:

- In *Orissa State Lift Irrigation Corporation Case*, relief in the form of one time relaxation vide examination to be conducted by the AICTE was granted to those candidates/students who had taken admission in academic years beginning from 2001 and till 2004-2005. No relief was granted to the candidates who had taken admission in 2005 or thereafter.
- The employees to whom certain benefits/advantages were granted prior to the date of passing of the Judgment i.e. 03.11.2017 and who were eligible for one-time relaxation granted in the Judgment, then on passing the test conducted by AICTE-UGC in the 1st or 2nd attempt, all those benefits/advantages shall be restored to them and their degrees shall stand revived fully. These employees would continue to enjoy all such benefits as they

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were enjoying before passing of the Judgment and would also continue to be eligible for all further benefits accruing on the basis of their restored degrees.

- The degrees of such employees/candidates who were not granted any benefit/advantage prior to the date of passing of the Judgment i.e. 03.11.2017 and who were also eligible for one time relaxation granted in the Judgment, shall also stand validated on passing the examination conducted by AICTE - UGC in 1st or 2nd attempt. Such candidates shall be eligible for further consideration only from the date on which they passed the said examination i.e. from the date when their degree stands validated.
- The AICTE vide circular dated 09.06.2020 (CP-10) has also clarified that the certificates have been provided to all those candidates who have passed the examination conducted in compliance of the Judgment in Orissa Lift Irrigation Corporation case (supra) in the months of June and December, 2018 which validate the degrees awarded by the four deemed to be Universities as per the Judgment dated 03.11.2017.





Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to the subject noted above and to say that the matter regarding equivalency of weekend/part-time degrees (B.Tech/M.Tech.) in various Engineering disciplines awarded by Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science and Technology, Murthal, Sonapat, Haryana was under consideration with the Government. The clarifications have also been sought by the various departments in this regard from time to time.

2. Vide letter No. 42/178/2008-5GSI, dated 21.05.2009, the Technical Education Department was declared as a Nodal Department to give advice on the issues relating to equivalency aspects of qualification, recognition of degree/diploma qualification and recognition of Universities/Institutions in various disciplines. The Technical Education Department vide their Memo No. EC/Collages/2021/38-44, dated 16.07.2021 has conveyed that the Equivalency Committee of Technical Education Department has decided that the weekend/part-time degrees (B.Tech/M.Tech.) in various Engineering disciplines awarded by Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science and Technology, Murthal, Sonapat, Haryana are equivalent to the regular UG/PG Engineering degrees and are valid for recruitment and promotion.

3. In pursuance of the recommendation of Equivalency Committee of Technical Education Department, the Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science and Technology (DCRUST), Murthal, Sonapat, Haryana vide notification No. 90, dated 28.07.2021, has notified that the weekend/part-time degree (B.Tech./M.Tech.) in various Engineering disciplines awarded by Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science and Technology, Murthal are equivalent to the regular UG/PG Engineering degrees. A copy of the same is enclosed.

4. The matter has been duly considered by the Government and it has been decided that all regular UG/PG Engineering degrees as well as the weekend/ part-time degrees (B.Tech/M.Tech.) in various Engineering disciplines awarded by Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science and Technology (DCRUST), Murthal, Sonapat, Haryana are to be treated as equivalent for the purpose of appointments and promotions.

5. The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for its compliance in the letter and spirit.
