- i. Objective Questions carrying one (1) mark each is required to be set out from common syllabus meant for all utilities.
- ii. Descriptive questions carrying ten (10) marks each is required to be set out from the dedicated syllabus of respective Utility. Furthermore, one question in respect of UHBVNL/DHBVNL must be a numeric question relating to "Computation of Energy Bill or Charges for Theft or Charges for Unauthorized Use" as mentioned in the above Scheme of Allocation of Marks.
- iii. Short Description Questions carrying five (5) marks each is required to be set out from common syllabus meant for all utilities.

Adoption of above scheme of questions would confirm to the allocation of marks as contemplated in the revised syllabus as reproduced above.

Further, it is also requested to provide the Sample Question Papers and intimate Date

Sheet of the DAE of Engineering Officers & Subordinates as requested vide this Office Memo No. Ch-8/HPTI-375 dated 26.11.2020, at the earliest, so that candidates could be informed well before the exams.
