3. In HVPNL, the State Govt. instructions dated 20.11.2017 & instructions dated 04.04.2018 regarding providing limited cashless medical facility has been adopted vide memo no.Ch.20/NGE/G-191/Loose-II/2013 dated 21.12.2017 (**Annex-6**) and memo no.Ch.27/NGE/G-191/Loose-II/2013 dated 16.05.2018 (**Annex-7**) respectively.

4. HPGCL is following the State Government instructions in such matters. In order to maintain parity, it is proposed that State Govt. instructions regarding empanelment of new private hospitals for providing treatment to the Haryana Government employees/pensioners and their dependents and State Govt. instructions regarding Cashless Medical Facility as detailed above may be adopted in HPGCL.

3. To provide seamless and hassle free services to Haryana Govt. Employee/Pensioners and their dependents, the empanelled private hospitals shall extend all normal courtesies and facilitate the admission, treatment and discharge of Haryana Govt. beneficiaries with no delay or denial of medical facility.
4. A Nodal Officer shall be appointed at level of empanelled private hospital. The Nodal will communicate with the concerned Civil Surgeon or/ and department in case of any grievance.
5. In case of any emergency/disasters /overflow of patients in Govt. Hospital during epidemics the empanelled hospital will agree to share their ambulances, mortuary, ICU/CCU, Burn unit, ward beds etc. in need based manner.

6. All statutory Rules/Guidelines/Acts/Notifications issued by State Govt. from time to time (As already mentioned in the application form for New Empanelment Policy) shall be followed by the empanelled hospitals. The same shall be applicable on existing private empanelled hospitals.
7. The hospital will abide to all the National Programmes and its related IEC activities. The data needed for National Program or Health Indicators must be shared with Health Department. The same shall be applicable on existing private empanelled hospitals.
8. The hospital shall follow the birth & death guidelines issued by the State Government from time to time. Any software developed by the Govt. will have to be adopted by the hospital.
9. It will be the responsibility of the hospital to provide accreditation certificate and further renewal certificate well before the expiry date.
10. Guidelines already framed under State Govt. policy dated 21.05.2015 for empanelled hospitals shall be applicable on new empanelled hospitals. However, when New Packages are made & or some services are started in Cashless mode new guidelines shall be issued for compliance with consent of concerned hospital.
11. The above listed hospitals will remain empanelled for period of three years subject to validity of accreditation certificate. Thereafter, the hospital will apply afresh.
12. Health Department reserves the right to call for record of treatment of any patient from any empanelled hospital to ensure no mal-practise takes place.
13. The reimbursement on expenditure incurred on non package treatment will be allowed at PGI Chd. Rates +75% of the balance amount.
14. All empanelled hospitals will maintain record of the treatment of the patients.
15. Ordinary no relaxation from the policy shall be given. For the convenience of the employees/pensioners and their dependents however, relaxation can be granted in exceptional cases will prior approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister and Finance Department. Such relaxation can be granted in the conditions like treatment of a very old person, highly sensitive nature of disease involving multi-system disorder and treatments taken in life threatening emergency situation etc. Justification for such expenditure, however, shall have to be first obtained from a committee of experts headed by DGHS and two subject specialists posted in Panchkula or PGIMS, Rohtak.
