

NOTICE

In pursuance of the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Power (MoP) vide letter/guidelines dated 30.01.2026 regarding utilization and allocation of fly ash, all Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) firms engaged in manufacturing of ash-based products and local users located within a radius of 100 km from Panipat Thermal Power Station (PTPS), Assan Kalan, Panipat are hereby requested to submit requisite documents for verification and record.

The interested firms/users shall submit self-attested copies of the following documents:

- I. Details regarding firm composition i.e. whether proprietary, partnership, company (Pvt. Or Public)
- II. Valid MSE/UDYAM Registration Certificate under manufacturing category indicating whether firm is Haryana based or outside.
- III. Audited Balance Sheets showing business turnover along with Profit & Loss Account statements of the company for the last 03 financial years (i.e. FY 2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26). **OR**
Certificate from a Chartered Accountant certifying the average turnover of the last 03 financial years (i.e. FY 2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26), clearly indicating year-wise turnover (as applicable)
- IV. PAN Card.
- V. GST Registration (as applicable).
- VI. Valid "Consent to Operate" the business issued by CPCB/SPCB.
- VII. Registration Certificate from concerned State Industries/Revenue Department or License to Work as a Factory (as applicable).
- VIII. Documentary evidence indicating the production capacity of the plant. Based on the annual production capacity, the annual allocation quantity of fly ash shall be determined by the Thermal Power Plant (TPP) at the appropriate stage.

Important Clarification

It is hereby clearly informed that submission of the above documents does not confer any right or claim for allocation of fly ash. This exercise is being undertaken only as a preliminary step to compile and verify the database of eligible MSE firms and local users, in order to facilitate and expedite the allocation process in future.

The allocation of Dry Fly Ash (DFA) shall be carried out separately at a later stage through issuance of a formal Expression of Interest (EOI) to interested parties. The quantity of DFA to be allocated and the applicable rates/terms & conditions shall be decided and communicated only at the time of issuance of such EOI.

All eligible firms/users are required to submit the above documents in sealed envelope (duly stamped) to the office of undersigned on or before 10.06.2026. Applications received after the due date or found incomplete in any respect shall not be considered for further processing.
